## *Important Dance Notes...*

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- 1.) Many children are participating in the dance activities offered by the Ambassadors of Dance and Wylie ISD. While we do not attempt to compete with private dance studios, we do attempt to provide a good enjoyable learning environment for all the children involved in our program.
- 2.) We ask your cooperation with several matters. One of these concerns attendance. **Regular attendance is necessary.** It is unfair to other students if your child misses frequently and has to get “caught up”. We ask that if you find your child will not be able to attend class on a regular basis, let us know immediately so that someone on the waiting list may fill his/her place.
- 3.) Parents of the younger dancers, **PLEASE BE SURE THAT YOUR CHILD HAS MADE A TRIP TO THE RESTROOM BEFORE ARRIVING AT HER DANCE CLASS.** Leotards and tights are difficult to get in and out of and Miss Gailyn is not able to leave the class to assist in this area. Moreover, as you might expect, the need to go to the restroom can reach EPIDEMIC proportions in that age group.
- 4.) Most students have tap shoes tied with ribbon. This ribbon will not stay tied. Please replace the ribbon with elastic, allowing enough “give” in the elastic for your child’s feet to slide comfortably into the shoe, but tight enough to keep her shoes from “flopping”. The ends of the elastic can be tied into permanent knots or stitched together. If you prefer, elastic ponytail holders can be used instead of elastic. **Please mark all shoes and dance bags with your child’s name clearly and with a permanent marker.**
- 5.) Please be prompt in bringing your child to class and picking him/her up. Most importantly for the dancer’s safety, we ask that he/she be picked up from inside the building after class. An unsafe situation exists if the children go outside to wait for their moms, especially if moms are late in picking them up. For this reason, Miss Gailyn will keep the children inside until someone comes for them. As it will be difficult to conduct class and watch those who are waiting for their moms, we again emphasize the importance of picking up your child on time. We will try our best to see that the dancers are dismissed promptly. If your child is to walk home, please notify us of those plans. We are attaching a form concerning this matter. We ask that you return the attached form along with the registration form to the same address.
- 6.) **VERY IMPORTANT!** While waiting in the hallway for dance classes to end, please keep your children with you at all times. Running, roller blading, throwing balls etc., is not allowed. We are very fortunate to have continued use of Hartman Elementary for our classes and must show the same respect for the building that is required of Hartman students. We thank you in advance for your continued cooperation and it is greatly appreciated!
- 7.) Spectators are not allowed in classes. The last class of this session will be an observation day when family and friends may come to see the dancers in action.
- 8.) **CLASSES FOR THE FALL SESSION BEGIN THE WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 8, 2008, AND END THE WEEK OF DECEMBER 1, 2008.** No classes will be held November 24-28, 2008. The Fall Semester concludes with Observation Week; December 1-4, 2008. As a rule, if the schools are closed for bad weather or school holidays, dance classes are also cancelled. At the end of the fall session dancers may pre-register for the spring session which begins in January and concludes with a formal recital in early May.
- 9.) **FEES ...** Fall session tuition is due at the time of registration. Spring session tuition is due by the end of January. Half of the costume fee is due the last week of dance in the fall session (during observation week) and the other half is due in the spring session (approx. Feb). **It is important that dance payment accounts be kept current.**

## 2008-2009 Policies

### Student Code of Conduct Policy

The Ambassadors of Dance is implementing a Student Code of Conduct Policy which all dancers are expected to exercise. Signatures of parents and/or students will validate agreement and initiation of the policy. Upon two (2) violations of acceptable conduct, the parent of the student will be called and the student will sit out the remainder of the class. If a 3<sup>rd</sup> violation occurs, the student will be dismissed from the Ambassadors of Dance program. A refund will then be issued on a pro-rated basis. *Students age 6 and under need not sign the agreement.*

### Acceptable conduct:

- A bodysuit or leotard with a skirt or dance shorts.
- Be on time to class.
- Respect and be kind to others.
- Listen carefully to directions, and obey them.
- Raise your hand before you ask a question.
- Listen quietly while others are speaking.
- Do not chew gum during class.
- Do not bring food to class.
- Do not bring drinks to class.
- Do not have cell phones on during class.

## **Student Dress Code Policy**

The Ambassadors of Dance is implementing a Student Dress Policy which all dancers and parents are expected to exercise. Signatures of parents and/or students will validate agreement and initiation of the policy. *Students age 6 and under need not sign the agreement.*

### **Acceptable Dancewear**

#### **Ballet**

- A bodysuit or leotard with a skirt or dance shorts.
- Thin socks and/or tights.

#### **Pointe**

- A bodysuit or leotard with a skirt or dance shorts.
- Tights. No socks allowed.

#### **Tap**

- A bodysuit or leotard, with skirts or shorts or t-shirt with dance shorts.
- Socks and/or tights.

#### **Jazz**

- A bodysuit or leotard, with skirts or shorts or t-shirt with dance shorts.  
Jazz pants with length above the shoe.
- Socks and/or tights.

### **Non-acceptable Dancewear**

#### **Ballet, Pointe, Tap, Jazz**

- Any type of jeans, long pants, long skirt, pajamas, house shoes.
